

Royal Dutch Kennelclub 'CYNOPHILIA'

In recent years the Alpine countries (Austria, Switzerland and Italy) have organised an annual Obedience Competition for the Alpine Trophy.

During the last FCI meeting on 6 October 2006, the delegates of the Obedience Committee raised the idea of renaming this event into the Joop de Reus Memorial Cup. The Netherlands will be the first country to organise this competition, which will take place on August 4th and 5th in Kerkwijk (near 's Hertogenbosch).

Registration is open for:

- Pure bred dogs – G&GIII – competing for the CACOB/CACIOB award and the Joop de Reus Memorial Cup GG III
- Non-pure bred dogs – G&G III – competing for the Joop de Reus Memorial Cup GG III
- Pure bred and non-pure bred dogs – G&G II – competing for the Joop de Reus Memorial Cup GG II
- Pure bred and non-pure bred dogs – G&G I – competing for the Joop de Reus Memorial Cup GG I

On both days the CACOB/CACIOB will be awarded. In order to be eligible for the "International Obedience Champion" title, the dog must have at least two CACIOB awards in at least two different countries, awarded by at least two different judges and at least one VERY GOOD judgement in a CAC/CACIB show. A period of one year and one day must elapse between the two CACIOB awards.

For the "National Obedience Champion" (CACOB) title, a dog must achieve the highest number of points, providing this amount is at least 255 of the total 320 points that can be awarded, at least 4 other dogs must participate, and the dog must be at least two years old on the day of the competition.

GENERAL INFORMATION

To participate in the CACOB/CACIOB International Obedience Competition, the dog and the handler must pass an examination within the highest obedience classification in their own country.

For taking part in the G&G I, II or G&G III competition, you may register dogs that have successfully passed the appropriate G&G I, G&G II or G&G III examination.

Dogs suffering from a contagious disease, hookworm, scabs or any other disorder, as well as dogs that are aggressive, blind or deaf are excluded from the competition.

Dogs that are cropped and were born in the Netherlands after 30 april 1989 or in another country after the legal ban on cropping was in force in that country or if born after 1 October 1996 in any country whatsoever cannot be registered for this competition.

A dog that has its tail docked and was born in the Netherlands after 31 August 2001 or abroad after the legal ban on docking was in force in that country cannot be registered for this competition.

Dogs with amputated tails can participate in this show providing the amputation was the result of a medical necessity. The statement concerning the required amputation has to be entered in the European animal passport by a practicing veterinarian.

For this purpose you can use the page indicated for operations. The statement in the animal passport must include the reasons (medical indications) and the date of the amputation, as well as a stamp clearly showing the name, address and original signature of the veterinarian. Dog owners must be capable of proving that their dogs are adequately vaccinated with standard vaccinations and a valid date.

Included please find the registration form and additional information concerning the International Open Obedience Competition for the Joop de Reus Memorial Cup.

This registration form must be submitted with the following:

a. For pure bred dogs

A copy of the pedigree certificate together with a copy of the page in the breed logbook that contains the data about the dog

b. For non-pure bred dogs

A copy of the page in the workbook that contains data about the dog

The registration fee must be paid at the same time.
